WHITES



White is the blank canvas that rests with serenity and confidence, waiting for us to paint our imaginations upon it. Though white can also be playful ... it is the perennial shape-shifter... it can calm or it can excite, confront or inspire. It is both primordial in its references to glacial ages past and yet utterly modern in its versatility and its knowledge of our ability to control, purify and manipulate our environment.

White can be opaque or translucent, crystalline hard or gossamer soft, dense or delicate, attention-seeking or discreet... but it is always compelling and meaningful.

The spatial positioning of white can offset grain, enhance pattern, offer sharp definition or pale into infinity and it can balance the effects of matt or gloss, open out or pull together. White can seem to transcend the hold of substance and yet its satisfyingly solidity when captive in a surface material means that it partners perfectly with steel or stone, timber or fabric, natural or synthetic.

GRAYS AND BLACKS

With an exquisitely nuanced versatility, gray is the secret-keeper of the colour spectrum, capable of taking on many roles and disguises. Chic, refined and sophisticated it draws its strength from the primordial minerals of nature, and as mysterious as it can seem, it nurtures the birth of so many ideas, so much creativity in its understated adaptability. Spanning the tonal landscape between dark and light, gray modulates the shadows and offers restrained contrast, either encouraging other colours to emerge boldly from the background or to quietly retreat to restfulness. In paler tones and in certain circumstances gray actively competes with white in its ability to increase a sense of space. In can take on warmth with a light touch of yellow or move back to coolness with traces of violet and blue. Gray can take the edge off harder blacks with its graceful flair for reflectivity.

Polished or honed, multi-talented gray can be either the star of the show or its reliable supporting cast. Deep, absorbing tones add gravity, while in lightness it softens the ambience with an ethereal insight. As a solid surfacing choice, the profound consistency of the carefully chosen grays in the DuPont[™] Corian[®] Tones collection enables their application to a significant range of creative projects, while the singular, saturated black in this presentation does everything that could be asked of a colour of such completeness.


YELLOW, ORANGE AND RED

These colours demand to be noticed and can eagerly absorb the light, however, there is both a youthful readiness and a resonant maturity in long familiar hues that were among the first to enhance human creativity.

Traditional pigments enabled the expression of decorative energy in some of our earliest forays into art and architecture, and this combined with our attraction to the ripeness of food that is ready to enjoy has long been translated into objects of desire. From the ceramic glazes of dynastic empires to the fading frescoes of civilisations past...red, orange and yellow have represented treasure, nobility and primal power. Personified here in such a modern and versatile material, this heritage takes on new and resolute life.






BROWNS AND PURPLES
